#### AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

The Code of the Town of Elkton
Title 10
Vehicles and Traffic
Chapter 10.16
Parking Schedules
Section 10.16.010 Parking Time Limited - Specified Areas.

**FOR THE PURPOSE** of amending the Code of the Town of Elkton, Title 10, Chapter 10.16, § 10.16.010., Parking Time Limited - Specified Areas, provided for 2-hour limited parking on North Street, between Main Street and Railroad Avenue.

**WHEREAS**, Article XI-E, Constitution of the State of Maryland; Article 23A, Annotated Code of Maryland; and the Charter and Code of the Town of Elkton provide the authority under which the Board of Commissioners may adopt, repeal, and/or amend the ordinances of the Town of Elkton; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Commissioners have previously enacted an ordinance to restrict certain streets in the downtown business district; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Commissioners have determined that parking on North Street, between Main Street and Railroad Avenue, should be limited to two (2) hours to accommodate local business and provide opportunities for citizens, customers, and visitors to the town to utilize this street for limited parking.

### **NOW, THEREFORE,** the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Elkton hereby ordains that:

- Section 1. The Code of the Town of Elkton, Title 10, Chapter 10.16, § 10.16.010., Parking time limited Specified areas, is hereby repealed; and
- Section 2. The Code of the Town of Elkton, Title 10, Chapter 10.16, § 10.16.010., Parking time limited Specified areas., is hereby re-enacted to read as follows:

No person shall park a vehicle or allow the same to remain parked upon any other streets or parts of streets described below, between the hours specified, for longer than the time indicated below:
