Ms. Newton called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM and stated that this is a meeting of the Historic District Commission and that a quorum was present. Resolution R1-2017 Elkton Historic District Design Guidelines

Phil Yocum and Candace Myruski from Commonwealth Heritage Group introduced themselves to the Commission. They stated that they were before the Commission to present the final draft of the Elkton Historic District Design Guidelines (HDDG). They presented a power point presentation illustrating the purpose of the HDDG, who the HDDG help in decision making, Elkton's path to recognizing the need for HDDG, and a short overview of the chapters within the HDDG.

Discussion ensued on how the HDDG would help the Commission in their decision making when applicants come before them, of different unique and interesting buildings within the Historic District, what to emphasize during the presentation to the Mayor and Commissioners, and the overall application procedures for historic district work permits in relation to the building permit application process.
