**Resolution R2-2015
Community Legacy Grant
Application**

A **RESOLUTION** of the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton approving the application and receipt of financing for the Elkton Downtown Façade Improvement Project (the "Project") further described in the Community Legacy Grant Application (the "Application") to be financed either directly by the Department of Housing and Community Development (the "Department") of the State of Maryland or through other departments or agencies of the State of Maryland.

WHEREAS, the Town of Elkton recognizes that there is a significant need for reinvestment and revitalization of the communities in the Town of Elkton; and

WHEREAS, the Department, either through Community Legacy or through other Programs of the Department, or in cooperation with other State departments or agencies, may provide some or all of the financing for the Project (Project Financing) in order to assist in making it financially feasible; and

WHEREAS, the Project is located within a priority funding area under Section 5-7B-02 of the Smart Growth Act, and the Project will conform to the local zoning code; and

WHEREAS, the applicable laws and regulations require approval of the Community Legacy Project and the Project Financing by the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton, and, where appropriate, by the chief elected executive official of the local subdivision;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton hereby approve the request for financial assistance in the form of a grant or loan, up to the amount of \$50,000.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the chief elected executive official be designated, and is hereby requested, to endorse this Resolution, thereby indicating the Mayor and Commissioners' approval thereof; and







Resolution R1-2015
Disposal of Surplus Property


WHEREAS, the following Town-owned property has exceeded its service life due age, and/or general condition and is recommended for disposal as surplus property.

1. That the following property be declared surplus property:

2. That the Town Administrator shall hereinafter dispose of the aforementioned firearm by sale to a Maryland licensed firearm dealer; and
3. That the proceeds of the sale of the aforementioned firearm shall be deposited in the General Fund.


