

**TOWN OF ELKTON
PEDDLING AND SOLICITING**

A “peddler” means a person, firm, corporation or legal entity engaged in business for profit who sells or offers for sale any commodity or article, traveling from place to place within the Town of Elkton. The Code of the Town of Elkton, Chapter 5.08, §5.08.020, states that it is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to engage in the business of hawker or peddler of any merchandise without having first secured a license from the Town of Elkton. A permit application must be submitted to the Administration Office. The Town will require personal information about the applicant in addition to providing proof of having obtained a Maryland State Transient Vendor’s License. State Transient Vendor’s Licenses can be obtained by visiting www.comp.state.md.us. The Town shall promptly verify facts included in the application and shall complete the process within fourteen (14) days after the filing of the registration statement. ***CLICK HERE*** to print a peddler’s permit application.

Fees for a peddler’s permit:
Annual license - \$50.00
Six-month license - \$25.00
Daily license - \$5.00

**TOWN OF ELKTON
TRANSIENT OR TEMPORARY DEALERS**

“Transient dealers” and “temporary dealers” means all persons, partnerships, corporations and any legal entity who engage in or conduct a temporary or transient business, either in one locality or in traveling from place to place, within the Town of Elkton, for the purpose of selling or soliciting merchandise or products, with the intention of continuing business for a period of not more than one year, and who set up and occupy any specific area for a period of time while selling said merchandise or products. The Code of the Town of Elkton, Chapter 5.08, §5.08.090, states that all transient or temporary dealers are required to obtain a license prior to conducting the aforementioned type of business in the Town of Elkton. A permit application must be submitted to the Administration Office. The Town will require personal information about the applicant in addition to providing a copy of a certificate from the State Department of Assessments and Taxation evidencing that the dealer has qualified to do business in Maryland and has met all State of Maryland requirements. Please visit www.comp.state.md.us to obtain certification from the State. A transient vendor’s permit application must be submitted at least twenty (20) days prior to the holding of a sale. ***CLICK HERE*** to print a transient vendor’s permit application for the Town of Elkton.

Fees for a transient vendor’s permit:
Annual license - \$50.00
Six-month license - \$25.00
Daily license - \$5.00
