AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

**The Code of the Town of Elkton
Title 10
Chapter 10.08
STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING**

FOR THE PURPOSE of amending the Code of the Town of Elkton, Title 10, Chapter 10.08, Stopping, Standing or Parking, §10.08.090, Parking on public property; by prohibiting parking of mobile homes and/or other recreational vehicles on Town-owned property.

WHEREAS, Article XI-E., Constitution of the State of Maryland; Section 4-103(b)(3), Subtitle 1, Title 4, Division II, Local Government Article, Annotated Code of Maryland; the Charter and Code of the Town of Elkton provide the authority under which the Mayor and Commissioners may adopt, repeal, and/or amend the ordinances of the Town of Elkton; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton hereby and ordain the following:

Section 1. The Code of the Town of Elkton, Title 10, Vehicles and Traffic, Chapter 10.08, Stopping, Standing or Parking, §10.08.090, Parking on public property, shall be amended and shall read as follows:

§10.08.090 Parking on Public Property

Section: §10.08.090 Parking on Public Property

- A. Maximum Time Permitted. A person shall not park or leave unattended any trailer, boat trailer, camping trailer, fifth wheel trailer, pole trailer, semitrailer, ~~or~~ travel trailer, mobile home, or park model recreational vehicle as defined under the Maryland Transportation Article, Title 11, upon any street, parking lot or other land owned by the Town for a period exceeding forty-eight (48) hours.
- B. No trailer, boat trailer, camping trailer, fifth wheel trailer, pole trailer, semitrailer, travel trailer, mobile home, or park model recreational vehicle as defined under the Maryland Transportation Article, Title 11, shall be used by any person as a dwelling house, place of abode or sleeping place while parked upon any street, parking lot or other land owned by the Town of Elkton.
- C. Unregistered or improperly registered vehicles. A person shall not park an unregistered or improperly registered vehicle upon a street, parking lot or other land of the Town.
- D. Inoperative vehicle. A person shall not park an inoperative vehicle upon a street, parking lot or land of the Town for a period exceeding forty-eight (48) hours. (Amended by Ord. 14-2002, eff.: 12/24/02)
