



## The Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton

### Resolution R1 - 2008

**A RESOLUTION** of the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton authorizing a salary adjustment for the Mayor and Commissioners.

**WHEREAS**, under the authority of the Charter of the Town of Elkton, Article IV., § C4-3., as amended by Resolution R5-2007, passed on October 17, 2007 and effective on December 6, 2007, the Mayor and Commissioners shall receive a salary and may adjust said salary by a Resolution of the Board passed during the regular course of business, but said adjustment shall not be applicable during the term of office of any member of the Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Commissioners commit increasingly more hours of their time to administrative duties, inter-governmental involvement, participation in government related organizations and community activities, as well as interaction with constituents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Commissioners have deemed that their respective salaries should be adjusted commensurate with the time and quality of their commitment as public officials.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton hereby resolve the following:

- Section 1. That the annual salary of the Mayor shall be adjusted from Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) to Nine Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$9,200.00).
- Section 2. That the annual salary of each Commissioner shall be adjusted from Seven Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$7,200.00) to Eight Thousand, Two Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$8,280.00).
- Section 3. That the annual salary adjustment shall be effective in accordance with the Charter of the Town of Elkton, Article IV., § C4-3, which provides that an adjustment to the salary of the Mayor and/or any member of the Board of Commissioners shall not apply during their respective term of office.
- Section 4. That the Mayor and Commissioners shall receive compensation at a rate of 1/26th of their respective annual salary on a biweekly basis consistent with the payroll administration for employees of the Town.
