"Maryland Municipal League Geocache Trail Resolution"

**WHEREAS**, Town of Elkton is a member of the Maryland Municipal League hereafter (MML), a voluntary, nonprofit, nonpartisan association controlled and maintained by city and town governments; and

**WHEREAS**, The MML works to strengthen the role and capacity of municipal government; and

**WHEREAS**, Tourism is one of the top industries in the United States and Maryland generating jobs and tax revenue; and

**WHEREAS,** Maryland residents make up one third of the State's tourists; and

**WHEREAS,** The MML works to educate citizens about the fact that only 157 of the place names on the State map are incorporated cities or towns; and

**WHEREAS,** Geocaching (a high-tech treasure hunt) is a rapidly growing form of tourism where people use GPS units to find the caches that individuals and organizations have hidden all over the world and then share the information about these caches on the internet; and

**WHEREAS,** The Maryland Municipal League Geocache Trail will be exclusively composed of caches hidden in Maryland cities and towns; and

**WHEREAS,** The Maryland Municipal League Geocache Trail will be publicized in many ways by the MML, the Maryland Geocaching Society, and the Maryland Office of Tourism; and

**WHEREAS,** Visitors using the Maryland Municipal League Geocache Trail will learn about Maryland cities and towns while contributing to their economy; and

**WHEREAS,** The Town of Elkton had previously participated in the MML Geocache Trail and would like to continue said involvement through and including the months of June - December 2009.

- \* Will participate in the Maryland Municipal League Geocache Trail.
- \* Will maintain the Geocache.
- \* Will adhere to geocaching standards and procedures.
