## Resolution R6-2005

**A RESOLUTION** of the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton approving the application for *Small Cities Community Development Block Grant* (CDBG) funds through the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for the *Elkton Sidewalk Rehabilitation Project*.

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development solicited applications from eligible political subdivisions for federal funds under the *Small Cities Community Development Block Grant* program to plan, develop and implement eligible community improvement projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Elkton is an eligible political subdivision that has identified a public improvement project that would serve an area wide benefit, the *Elkton Sidewalk Rehabilitation Project*, involving the construction, repair and installation of sidewalks and appropriate improvements to accommodate disabled citizens in compliance with the *Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)*; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Commissioners held a public hearing regarding the CDBG application on Wednesday, May 18, 2005 7:05 p.m., Elkton Municipal Building, 100 Railroad Avenue, Elkton, Maryland, in accordance with CDBG program requirements.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton hereby resolve the following:

- 1. The application for *Small Cities Community Development Block Grant* funds be submitted to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development in the amount of **One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars** (\$120,000.00) for use by the Town to plan, develop, and implement the *Elkton Sidewalk Rehabilitation Project*; and
- 2. Mayor Joseph L. Fisona is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary and required under the *Small Cities Community Development Block Grant* program.
