Resolution 8-2004

A RESOLUTION of the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton supporting the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development, Neighborhood Business Development Program financing to the Elkton Alliance, Inc.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Commissioners are interested in promoting the revitalization of the Elkton community by encouraging the development and expansion of for-profit and nonprofit small businesses; and

WHEREAS, the Elkton Alliance, Inc., applied to the Neighborhood Business Development program for financing the revitalization of the *Historic King Hardware Building*, 140-142 West Main Street, specifically identified on Tax Map 307, as parcel 1384, and owned by Colonel's D & D Choice, LLC, hereinafter the "Project"; and

WHEREAS, this Project is located in Elkton's *Central Business District*, a Maryland-approved, locally designated revitalization area and conforms to the local zoning code; and

WHEREAS, the regulations of the Neighborhood Business Development Program require that all projects receiving financing be approved and supported by the governing body of the locality in which the project is situated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton hereby endorse the financing of the Elkton Alliance, Inc., for the Project; and
