



## The Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton

### Resolution R2-2007

**A RESOLUTION** of the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton authorizing a salary adjustment for the Mayor and Commissioners and funding allocation in the FY 2008 annual budget.

**WHEREAS**, under the authority of the Charter of the Town of Elkton, Article IV., § C4-3., the Mayor and Commissioners shall receive a salary and may adjust said salary by a resolution of the Board passed during the regular course of business; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Commissioners commit increasingly more hours of their time to administrative duties, inter-governmental involvement, participation in government related organizations and community activities, as well as interaction with constituents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Commissioners have deemed that their respective salaries should be adjusted commensurate with the time and quality of their commitment as public officials and consequently have allocated appropriate funds in the FY 2008 annual budget for a salary adjustment.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton hereby resolve the following:

- Section 1. That the annual salary of the Mayor shall be adjusted from Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) to Ten Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$10,800.00).
- Section 2. That the annual salary of each Commissioner shall be adjusted from Seven Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$7,200.00) to Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$9,720.00).
- Section 3. That the annual salary adjustment shall be effective July 1, 2007.
- Section 4. That the Mayor and Commissioners shall receive compensation at a rate of 1/26th of their respective annual salary on a biweekly basis consistent with the payroll administration for employees of the Town.
