Resolution R7-2022 Community Legacy Grant Application

A RESOLUTION of the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton approving the application and receipt of financing for a **Community Legacy** project for the *Elkton Building Improvement Program* ("Project") further described in the application submitted to the Department of Housing and Community Development on July 13, 2022 ("Application"), to be financed either directly by the Department of Housing and Community Development ("Department") or through other departments or agencies of the State of Maryland.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton recognize that there is a significant need for reinvestment and revitalization in Cecil County and the Elkton community; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Elkton supports the continuation of a successful building improvement program targeting commercial properties in downtown Elkton; and

WHEREAS, the Department, either through Community Legacy, Community Legacy-Neighborhood Intervention, Strategic Demolition Fund, Baltimore Regional Neighborhood Initiative or through other programs of the Department, or in cooperation with other Maryland departments or agencies that may provide some or all of the financing for the Project (the "Project Financing") in order to assist in making it financially feasible; and

WHEREAS, the Project is located within a *Priority Funding Area* under Section 5-7B-02 of the Smart Growth Act, and the Project will conform to the local zoning regulations; and

WHEREAS, the applicable law and regulations require approval of the Project and the Project Financing by the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton and by Mayor Robert J. Alt, as the chief elected executive officer of the Town of Elkton.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton hereby endorse the Project in the *Sustainable Community Area* and approve the request for financial assistance in the form of a grant in the amount of \$60,000.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Mayor Robert J. Alt, as the Town of Elkton's chief elected executive official, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents and take any action necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this Resolution be sent to the Honorable Kenneth C. Holt, Secretary, Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland.
