

Elkton Trash & Recycling

Fact Sheet

- What is the change?
 - **STARTING MONDAY NOVEMBER 7**, Waste Management will be collecting **BOTH** regular trash and recycling on the same day using 2 different trucks. Please have your trash on the curb no later than 6 AM
 - WM will pick up one can (or toter) only for trash and one can (or toter) for recycling
 - WM will no longer accept unscheduled bulk item pick-up; see bulk pickup procedures below
- What are the collection days?
 - Sorted by Neighborhood, the collection days will be either **Monday**, **Tuesday** or **Thursday**:

- Why are we changing?
 - To make trash pick- ups more efficient
 - To encourage residents of Elkton to recycle and reduce their waste
 - To reduce costs of the landfill fees to the residents
- Why should we recycle?
 - Elkton residents average 47 pounds of trash per week (National average is 30 pounds)
 - Elkton Residents average 5.5 pounds of recycling material per week (National average is 10 pounds)
- How does Bulk Pick-up Work?
 - **Bulk Pickups** (one large item (including mattresses)) will be scheduled once a month.
 - **Call the Department of Public Works at 410-392-6636 to schedule**
- Are toters /trash cans available?
 - Toters / trash cans are not supplied by WM or the Town of Elkton
 - Toters / trash cans can be purchased from your local hardware or home improvement store
