Resolution R6-2014

A RESOLUTION of the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton adopting a Residential Anti-Displacement and Relocation Assistance Plan, a Citizen Participation Plan, a Section 3 Plan, a Minority Business Plan and a Fair Housing and Equal Opportunity Plan.

WHEREAS, the Town of Elkton has applied for and received funds through the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, administered by the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development; and

WHEREAS, the federal government requires the recipient of federal funds under the CDBG program to adopt and implement certain plans which incorporate minority business enterprises, provide for citizen antidisplacement and re-location assistance, allow for input from local citizens on the use and implementation of federal funds through a participation plan, and provide for the inclusion of lower income and disadvantaged persons within the community in the CDBG funded project; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Elkton has prepared plans in conformance with the aforesaid CDBG requirements, it is the intent of the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton to implement those plans.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton hereby adopt the following plans (attached herewith and made a part of this resolution):
